In India

Mix for Kids is going to support the non-profit organisation Don Bosco e.V. in Vadodara and Chotata, in the Indian state of Gujarat.

Don Bosco's desire was to give children holistic support as well as a home, provide them with training opportunities, share their free time and be attentive to their problems and concerns.

The Don Bosco Fathers connect with street children and invite them to open groups and/or children's homes, where they receive fresh clothes and food and can play with other children, learn and forget their worries and fears for a while.

The strong focus on athletic activities helps the children train team spirit and social interaction.

Women and their community

Don Bosco has also been working successfully with women in self-help groups. These women are provided with a tailor-made training program where they learn about processing herbs, labelling, pricing and marketing. The program's aim is to develop sources of income for the women and help them grow within their community.

In addition to working with people, the Don Bosco organisation is actively committed to promoting sustainable agriculture, with the goal of putting an end to conventional industrial production dependent on the use of large quantities of pesticides and synthetic fertilizers. Don Bosco's vision for the future of agriculture is small, sustainable and regenerative production systems. This would make it possible to grow eggplants, chilis, tomatoes and water melons, etc. at the same time and harvest them within one seasonal period. Pesticides and fertilizers are produced organically according to traditional recipes.
